NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that a casual vacancy is deemed to have occurred in the office of Councillor for the CHURCHSTOKE Ward of the Community of CHURCHSTOKE on the resignation/~~death~~ on 25/04/2005 of Councillor P DELVES.

Rule 8(1) of The Local Elections (Parishes and Communities) (Amendment) Rules, 1986, provides that on a casual vacancy occurring in the office of councillor of a community, an election to fill the vacancy shall be held if, within fourteen days (computed as stated below) after public notice of the vacancy has been given in accordance with Section 87(2) of the Local Government Act, 1972, notice in writing of a request for such an election has been given to the proper officer of the council of the county within which the community is situate by TEN electors for the electoral area.

The Proper Officer is the Deputy Returning Officer, County Secretary's Department, Powys County Council, Neuadd Maldwyn, Severn Road, Welshpool.
