**GRASS CUTTING & GROUNDS MAINTENANCE
Two year contract
2011 – 2012 and 2012 – 2013**

Tenders are invited to cover 2 seasons 2011 – 2012 and 2012 – 2013
for grass-cutting and grounds maintenance work as follows

A - Open Areas in the Communities of Churchstoke & Hyssington

- A1 6 cuts of areas in Churchstoke and Hyssington (further schedule details available from the Clerk). Please note that two of these areas (Cherry Tree Land and North Walk) are designated as 'Village Green' and a site visit may be required in order to indicate the boundaries.

B - Cemetery at Wernddu Lane, Churchstoke

- B1 hedge trimming of conifer and field hedges & disposal of cuttings
B2 mowing on a 7-10 day frequency & disposal of cuttings

C - Recreation Field at Cae Camlad, & Entrance to Cae Camlad, Churchstoke

- C1 18 mowings of main recreation field
C2 6 mowings at the allotments (previously known as Millennium Extension) of paths between plots and the rest area around the oak tree. Please note cutting is not required for the 14 allotment plots.
C3 1 cut of hedge between recreation field and Fir Court Estate & disposal of cuttings
C4 tending of rose beds & the adjacent long wall bed, at Cae Camlad & disposal of cuttings
C5 tending and removal of weed growth along the entrance road from Cae Camlad to recreation field, and disposal of cuttings

D - Playground at Cae Camlad, Churchstoke

- D1 18 mowings of playground & disposal of cuttings
D2 3 cuts of boundary hedges & disposal of cuttings

Tenders to cover areas A + B + C + D must be submitted in sealed envelopes
