The tree is an ancient yew tree. It was damaged during the gales in mid December. It is situated to the left of the path through the churchyard. A very large branch has splintered and is now resting on top of grave stones in the church yard. The work required is listed in the attached report from tree surgeon James Heap NCH(Arb). The fallen branch needs to be removed so that parishioners can access their graves. The tree requires further pruning work to ensure that further branches do not break off in high winds and to prolong its life. The work needs to be completed as soon as possible now whilst the tree is still dormant.

Trees protected by Tree Preservation Order should be numbered according to the First Schedule of the Tree Preservation Order. For example - T3 oak; two beech and one birch in G2.
