To whom it may concern,

Acting as the Agent for the applicant, the Stiperstones and Corndon Landscape Partnership Scheme is a 5 year programme of work (beginning in 2013) that aims to conserve, enhance and celebrate natural and cultural heritage in the Shropshire / Powys borderlands. The Scheme is funded by the Heritage Lottery Fund and involves a range of statutory and non-statutory partners (for further information visit: stiperstonesandcorndon.co.uk).

We have engaged with the landowner, Mr Don Pugh in support of our project 'Helping Hillforts & Earthwork Castles'. The project was designed to enhance appreciation by the local community of its archaeological heritage, by engaging volunteers in researching, exploring and managing a number of monuments within the scheme's boundaries. Hyssington Motte and Bailey Castle is one of four medieval sites that was selected by our partners, Cadw and the Clywd Powys Archaeological Trust, as it considered one of the best preserved, as well as one of the most vulnerable in the project area.

Along with the organisations mentioned above, the local community group in Hyssington and residents in the adjacent property have been consulted and have given their support for the work to be carried out.

A suitably qualified and insured Arborist has been contracted to undertake the tree works and will concentrate on the scrub and small understory trees on the motte/mound, within the scheduled area. The mature, veteran oak trees on both sides of the boundary will remain unaffected with no associated loss of amenity, wildlife or landscape character.

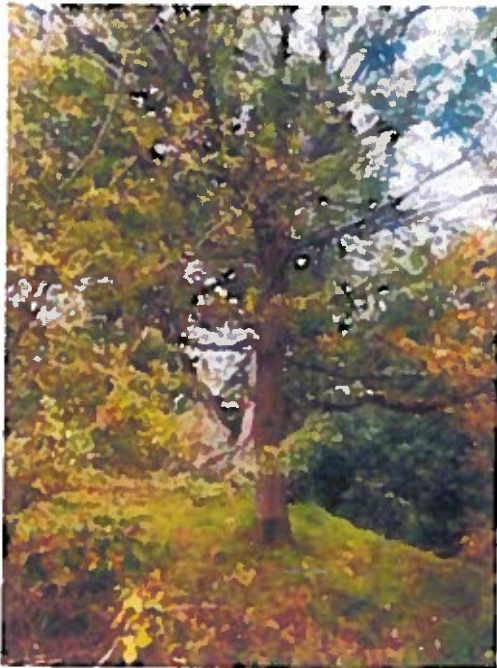

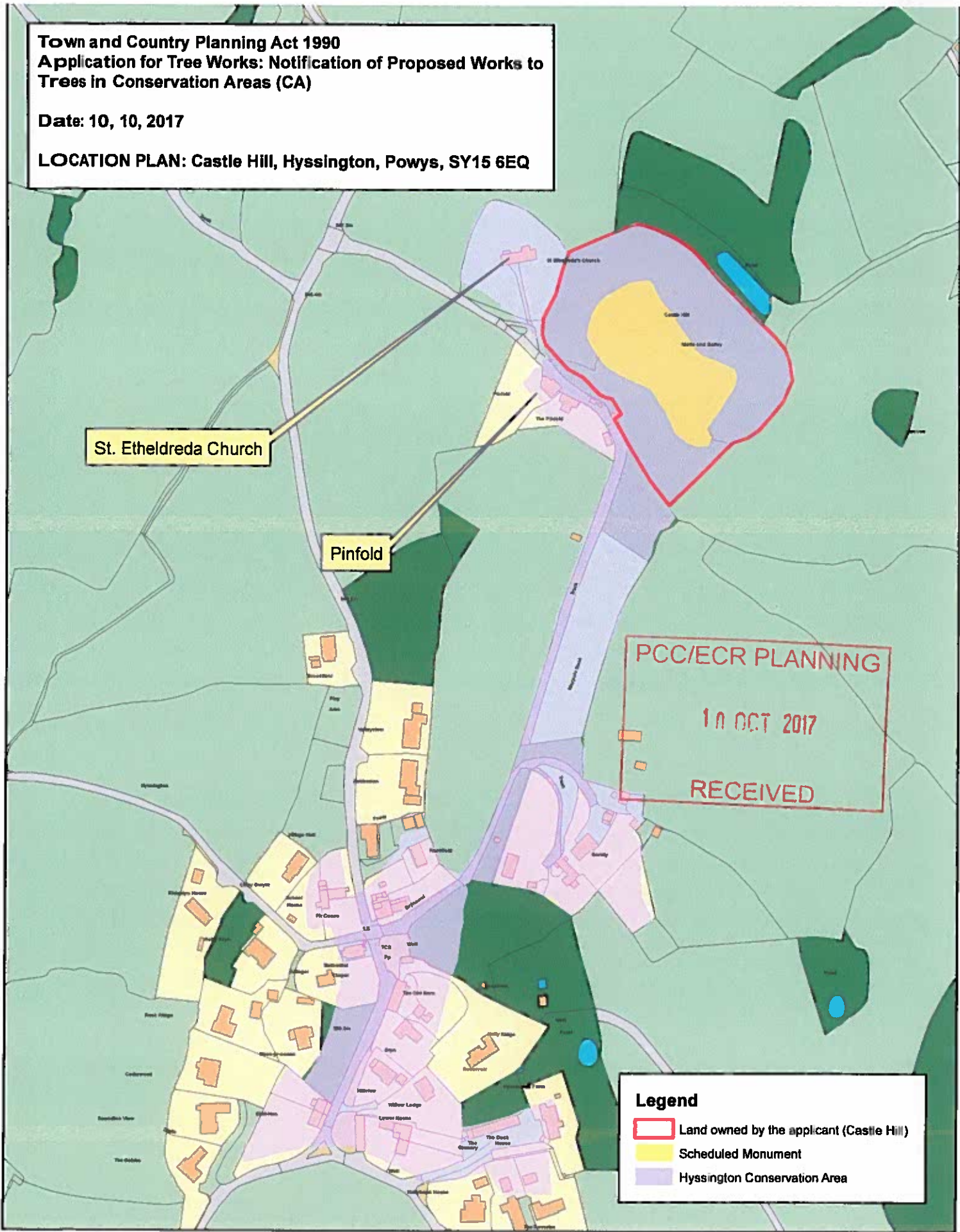

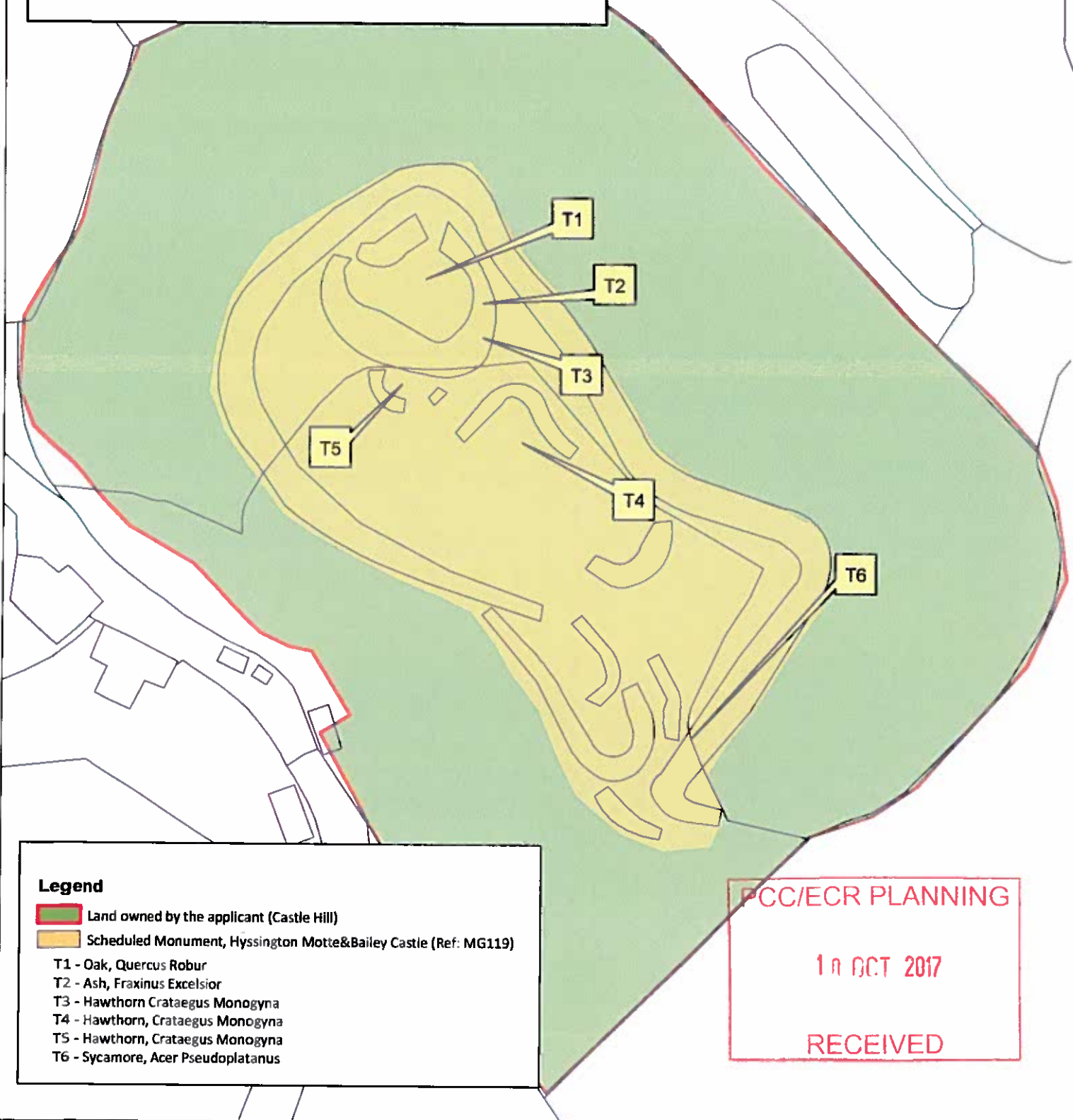
