- 10.1 Powys Teaching Health Board (PTHB): to report from an online briefing 24<sup>th</sup> Jun'25 on the proposed Health & Wellbeing Campus. The Clerk reminded Council of the opportunity to join the briefing which has been circulated to Members and reported from the 30 minute briefing as follows
- Attendance by four community & town councils, Powys County Council and 2 officers for the PTHB
  - Background: initiative to transform health and care in North Powys to 'level up' to other parts of the county

- Current position: in Mar'25 Welsh Government given the go-ahead for PTHB to develop an outline business case for a bid for £30m investment in phase 1 comprising training academy, dental clinic, new library, children and families centre, housing advice, wellbeing activity multi-use space, opening late 2028 or early 2029; later phase 2 covering a replacement hospital bringing out of county work back to Powys; phase 3 covering expanded range of diagnostic and treatment services
- Other work associated with but separate from the bid: new schools at Ysgol Calon Y Dderwen opening 2027, supported housing, student academy, and keyworker accommodation
- Next steps: work on the phase 1 proposals and submission to Welsh Government by end 2025.

10.2 Powys Teaching Health Board: to receive a next stage 'Better Together' consultation closing extended to 1<sup>st</sup> Aug'25, to resolve whether to respond and if so to elect to a working party to bring recommendations to the July meeting (paper 10.2a-d previously circulated).

The Chair referred Members to the consultation papers. The Clerk reminded Members of the earlier consultation (May'25) for which CCC resolved it did not wish to make a corporate response and encourages councillors to make their own individual responses, and this is a follow on next step exercise.
