2.1 Agenda Item 19.2 Land Registration at Hyssington

Mr S Griffin addressed Council for Friends Of The Green At Hyssington (FOTGAH) to provide a progress update with planned works to trees at the village green highlighting:

- Professional survey undertaken August 2017, identifying works needed to address damage being done by trees and general health and appearance of the trees
- Permission for works to trees in a conservation area obtained, with no conditions
- Currently seeking quotations from potential contractors to undertake the tree works in the best interest of the public (grant) funding
- A request is made to the community council for disposal timber via FOTGAH with the money proceeds channelled back into the project to help defray costs of the project.

The Chairman thanked Mr Griffin for addressing the Council.

3.0 Guest: Severn Rivers Trust: to welcome Mr Peter Powell, Severn Uplands and Shropshire Middle Severn Catchment Officer to describe the Severn Water Integration Management project, and opportunities for natural flood management of the Camlad River.

The Chairman welcomed Mr Powell to the meeting. Mr Powell described the work of the Severn Rivers Trust (SRT) highlighting:

- SRT being a charity set up 10 years ago with aims and objectives around fish and water quality in the Severn
- Illustrating examples of small scale work in the Camlad catchment area over a period of 4 years to keep the river clean
- SRT is now able to undertake larger pro-active schemes including fencing and tree planting, illustrating examples in Llanfyllin area
- SRT is about to receive a large financial grant from Welsh Government for work in areas including the Camlad catchment, for natural flood defences to alleviate flooding downstream by reducing run-off, with payments to off-set the effects of delayed drainage
- The overall scheme is valued at £1.4m during 2018
- At this stage SRT is seeking to raise awareness in communities, and would like to return in 12 months time to provide a progress update.

The Chairman thanked Mr Powell for attending and for describing the work of SRT and its scheme.


