- 2 planning contravention notice was issued to the site owner requesting information regarding the use of the two static caravans to the rear of Lyndon House, Churchstoke
- Site inspections were carried out on 3 different occasions since the registration of the complaint. The situation at the site had not changed on any of the visits
- The owner confirmed the one caravan wasn't being used and the second caravan was being used ancillary to the main house. This would be removed once renovation works were completed on the main house
- As the caravans aren't separated and remain ancillary to the main house within its garden area Officers don't consider a breach of planning has occurred.

Members reported the works to the house appear to have been completed some time ago and the caravans are still present notwithstanding the commitment they would be removed.
